1999 WISCONSIN ACT 159

AN ACT to amend 341.26 (2) (f) of the statutes; relating to: registration of vehicles operated exclusively by a non-profit organization as a blood bank vehicle.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 341.26 (2) (f) of the statutes is amended to read:

341.26 (2) (f) A motor vehicle operated exclusively

by a nonprofit organization, as defined in s. 108.02 (19), as a Red-Cross blood bank vehicle.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

(1) This act first applies to applications for motor vehicle registration submitted on the effective date of this subsection.

"Every act and every portion of an act enacted by the legislature over the governor's partial veto which does not expressly prescribe the time when it takes effect shall take effect on the day after its date of publication as designated" by the secretary of state [the date of publication may not be more than 10 working days after the date of enactment].
