**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 5,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 941**

March 29, 2000 – Offered by Representative CARPENTER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 5: after “committee,” insert “a sales tax and use tax exemption
3 for reusable incontinent underpads and briefs,”.

4 **2.** Page 5, line 22: after that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 10e.** 77.52 (2) (a) 6. of the statutes is amended to read:

6 77.52 (2) (a) 6. Laundry, dry cleaning, pressing and dyeing services, except
7 when performed on raw materials or goods in process destined for sale, except when
8 performed on cloth diapers by a diaper service, except when performed on reusable
9 incontinent underpads and briefs, regardless of their size, and except when the
10 service is performed by the customer through the use of coin-operated, self-service
11 machines.
