- (b) A health care coverage plan specified in par. (a)  $\bigvee$  may not require an 8 9 examination by or a referral from a physician as a condition precedent for the receipt of an acupuncturist's services under par. (a).  $\checkmark$ 10
- (2) The office of the commissioner of insurance shall study the impact of the 11 coverage requirement under sub. (1), considering such issues as the cost of the 12 13 coverage, utilization of the coverage, satisfaction with the coverage and the health 14 and well-being of employes utilizing the coverage, and shall determine the feasibility and advisability of requiring all insurers, as defined in s. 600.03 (27), 15 16 offering health care coverage to provide the coverage required under sub. (1). On or 17 before May 1, 2005, the commissioner of insurance shall report the findings of the study and legislative and other recommendations to the legislature under  $s_{13.172}^{V}$ 18 (2).19
