

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, nonrepresented state employes receive a total of nine paid holidays annually, while represented employes receive only the paid holidays provided for in their collective bargaining agreements. This bill provides that November 11 (the day on which Veteran's Day is traditionally celebrated) is a day on which the offices of the agencies of state government are closed. In addition, the bill increases the number of paid holidays for nonrepresented state employes from nine to ten days. Represented state employes continue to have the paid holidays provided for in their collective bargaining agreements.
