Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, money has been provided to construct 3 memorials at The Highground in Clark County: one for the veterans of World War I, one for the veterans of World War II and one for the veterans of the Persian Gulf War. This bill appropriates \$80,000 for the construction of a memorial at The Highground in Clark County for the veterans of the Korean War. The bill also appropriates \$90,000 for the perpetual care of the Korean War memorial located at Plover in Portage County.

For further information see the **state** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

From the general fund, as a 13 continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule to provide perpetual care for 14 the Korean War memorial located at Plover in Portage County. 15 **SECTION 4.** 45.03 (2m) of the statutes is created to read: 16 45.03 (2m) From the appropriation under s. 20.485 (2) (dk), the department 17 shall provide funding for the construction of a Korean War memorial at the veterans 18 memorial site located at The Highground in Clark County. 19 **SECTION** 5. 45.035 of the statutes is created to read: 20 **45.035 Korean War memorial at Plover.** From the appropriation under s.



Please note that s. 16.47 (2), stats., states that neither house may pass any bill containing an appropriation, increasing the cost of state government or decreasing state revenues by more than \$10,000 annually until both houses pass the executive budget bill, except that the governor or joint committee on finance or, under certain circumstances, the committee on organization of either house may enact emergency appropriation bills prior to the passage of the executive budget bill.

If this bill is introduced and enacted as an emergency measure prior to passage of the budget, the appropriation set forth in this bill will be repealed by action of the budget bill (which repeals and recreates the appropriations schedule). You may instead wish to consider having this bill drafted as an amendment to the budget bill to include the correct appropriation line amount. Alternatively, you may wish to include an effective date that is later than the projected date for passage of the budget bill. Finally, you may instead wish to introduce this bill for potential passage after the passage of the budget bill. If you choose this option, please check with me after budget passage to ensure that the crossreferences in this bill are still accurate and that the numbers for created statutes in the bill have not been supplanted by the budget bill.
