~~36.32 STUDENT IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS. The board may assign to each student enrolled in the system a unique identification number. The board shall not assign to any student an identification number that is identical to or incorporates the student's social security number. This subsection does not prohibit the board from requiring a student to disclose his or her social security number, nor from using a student's social security number if such use is required by a federal or state agency or private organization in order for the system or the student to participate in a particular program.~~

Under current law the ~~the~~ University of Wisconsin System, a technical college district board, a school board and the governing body of a private school are prohibited from assigning to any student an identification number that is identical <sup>to</sup> or incorporates the student's social security number.

Beginning January 1, 2002, this bill extends this prohibition to private institutions of higher education located in the state.
