The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 36.25 (23) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 36.25 (23) ROBERT M. LA FOLLETTE INSTITUTE OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS. There is established a Robert M. La Follette institute of public affairs at the University of Wisconsin–Madison. The institute shall engage in research, public service and
- 7 educational activities to advance the knowledge of public affairs and the application

- of that knowledge to the needs of this state. <u>Beginning in the 2000–01 academic year.</u>
