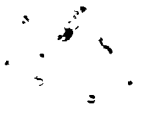

1 AN ACT to amend 36.25 (23) of the statutes; relating to: courses offered by the  
2 Robert M. La Follette Institute of Public Affairs.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill requires that at least 80% of the courses offered by the Robert M. La Follette Institute of Public Affairs at the University of Wisconsin-Madison be held after 5 p.m.

For further information see the state fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 36.25 (23) of the statutes is amended to read:

36.25 (23) ROBERT M. LA FOLLETTE INSTITUTE OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS. There is established a Robert M. La Follette institute of public affairs at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. The institute shall engage in research, public service and educational activities to advance the knowledge of public affairs and the application of that knowledge to the needs of this state. Beginning in the 1998-99 academic year, <sup>2000-01</sup> at least 80% of the courses offered by the <sup>LC</sup> Institute shall be held after 5 p.m.

If you choose to introduce the proposal without the fiscal estimate, the fiscal estimate will be requested automatically upon introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
