

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



This bill requires that at least 80% of the courses offered by the Robert M. La Follette Institute of Public Affairs at the University of Wisconsin-Madison be held after 5 p.m.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 36.25 (23) of the statutes is amended to read:

36.25 (23) ROBERT M. LA FOLLETTE INSTITUTE OF PUBLIC AFFAIRS. There is

established a Robert M. La Follette institute of public affairs at the University of

Wisconsin-Madison. The institute shall engage in research, public service and

educational activities to advance the knowledge of public affairs and the application ノレッシーン


