



Section #. 118.169 of the statutes is renumbered 118.169(1) and amended to read:

118.169 (Pupil identification numbers.) A sedhood board, and the governing body of a private school, may assign to each pupil enrolled in the school district or private school a unique identification number. The school board or governing body shall not assign to any pupil an identification number that is identical to or incorporates the pupil's social security number. This section does not prohibit a school board or governing body from requiring a pupil to disclose his or her social security 'e social security number if such use is required by a federal or state number, nor from using a student agency or private organization in order for the school district or private school to participate in a particular program.

NOTE: This section is created eff. 1-1-00 by 1997-Wis. Act 128.



In drafting this bill, I noticed that the prohibition on the use of a pupil's social security number in the pupil's identification number (enacted by 1997 Wisconsin Act 128) does not apply to the Milwaukee Public Schools. I corrected that in this draft. If you wish to delete this change, please let me know.

I also provided for an effective date of January 1, 2000, or the day after publication, whichever is later, in order to ensure that the provisions in this bill do not become effective before the provisions of Act 128. OK?
