Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law limits the increase in the total amount of revenue that a school district may receive from general school aids and property taxes in a school year to \*200 per pupil. Several exceptions are provided. For example, if a school district incréases the sèrvices that it provides by adding responsibility for providing a service transferred to it from another governmental unit, its revenue limit is increased by the cost of that service.

This bill provides that a school district's revenue limit is increased by an amount equal to the amount spent by the school district for measures designed to prevent criminal activity in schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 121.91 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
