

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT,

TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 45

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, line 13: after that line insert:

"Section 5m. 165.72 (2g) of the statutes is created to read:

165.72 (2g) After-hours message for calls concerning dangerous weapons in public schools. The department of justice shall provide for a telephone call to the telephone number maintained under sub. (2) to be received by a telephone answering system or service if the call is made after normal retail business hours. The telephone answering system or service shall provide a recorded message that requests the caller to call the telephone number "911" or an appropriate local law enforcement agency if the person is calling to provide information regarding dangerous weapons in a public school.".
