TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 45

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 2, line 13: after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 5m. 165.72 (2g) of the statutes is created to read:

4 165.72 (2g) AFTER-HOURS MESSAGE FOR CALLS CONCERNING DANGEROUS WEAPONS  
5 IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS. The department of justice shall provide for a telephone call to the  
6 telephone number maintained under sub. (2) to be received by a telephone answering  
7 system or service if the call is made after normal retail business hours. The  
8 telephone answering system or service shall provide a recorded message that  
9 requests the caller to call the telephone number "911" or an appropriate local law  
10 enforcement agency if the person is calling to provide information regarding  
11 dangerous weapons in a public school."
