3 "SECTION 5m. 165.72 (2g) of the statutes is created to read:

Stat See id.

4 165.72 (2g) AFTER-HOURS MESSAGE FOR CALLS CONCERNING DANGEROUS WEAPONS

5 IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS. If a call is made after normal retail business hours to the

6 telephone number maintained under sub. (2), the department of justice shall provide

7 for the call to be received by a telephone answering system or service. The telephone

8 answering system or service shall provide a recorded message that requests the

9 person calling to call the telephone number "911" or a local law enforcement agency

10 if the person is calling to provide information regarding dangerous weapons in a

11 public school."

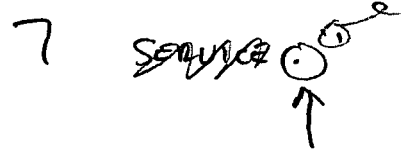

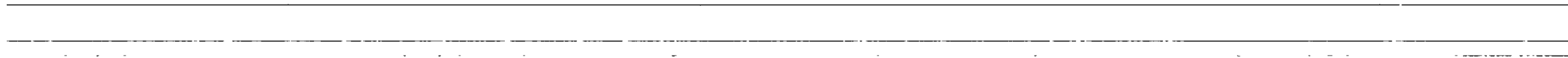
