#### HOTLINE FOR REPORTING DANGEROUS WEAPONS IN SCHOOLS

Assembly Bill 45 currently proposes the creation of a hotline for persons to report information regarding dangerous weapons in schools. The following proposal is intended to expand that to include any threat to damage school premises or a threat to harm any individual.

#### Senate Amendment 1 (Suggesti)

Page 2, line 2, insert after "Dangerous weapons" and threats to property or persons

Page 2, line 13, insert after sentence: or any threat to damage any property belonging to a school or located on school grounds or any threat to harm any individual on school grounds.

Page 2, line 17, insort after "public school" or a threat to damage any property belonging to a school or located on school grounds or any threat to harm any individual on school grounds
