

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 7,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 51**

January 26, 1999 – Offered by Representative ALBERS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 6, line 18: delete lines 18 to 23 and substitute:

3 “**(2)** In the event that an authority has reason to believe that a computer system
4 that is operated by any person over whom the authority has primary regulatory
5 power may fail to perform any action related to the date change necessitated by the
6 year 2000 or in the event of a computer system operated by such a person fails to
7 perform any act related to the date change necessitated by the year 2000 and that
8 computer system is a component of the activity that is regulated by that authority,
9 the authority may require the person to respond in writing to the following questions:

10 (a) “What pieces of computerized equipment do you have?”

11 (b) “Have you had all the pieces of that equipment associated with the activity
12 regulated by [name of authority] which contain any microprocessor chip with a date

1 and time mechanism checked by the manufacturer or another qualified professional
2 expert to determine whether the equipment functions properly after December 31,
3 1999? If not, please advise as to the date on which checking of all such equipment
4 will be completed.”.”
