This amendment creates a "babysitter exception", which allows a babysitter to transport children in nonemergency situations if the babysitter possesses a note signed by the child's parent or guardian indicating the authorized travel. Under this amendment, a babysitter must follow a direct route between permitted destinations and cannot be authorized just to drive around. OK?
