- AN ACT to create 77.54 (44) of the statutes; relating to: a sales tax exemption

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Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales tax and use tax exemption for goods and services sold to veterans organizations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 77.54 (44) of the statutes is created to read:
- 77.54 **(44)** The gross receipts from the sale of goods and services to, and the storage, use or other consumption of goods and services by, a state veterans organization, as defined in s. 45.353 (1) (b).
- 7 Section 2. Effective date.
