

This bill creates a sales tax and use tax exemption for goods and services sold to veterans organizations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 77.54 (43) of the statutes is created to read:

77.54 (44) The gross receipts from the sale of goods and services to, and the storage, use or other consumption of goods and services by, a state veterans organization, as defined in s. 45.353 (1) (b).

SECTION 2. Effective date.

(1) This act takes effect on the first day of the 2nd month beginning after publication.
