1 AN ACT *to create* 77.54 (43) of the statutes; relating to: a sales tax exemption

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales tax and use tax exemption for goods and services sold to veterans organizations.

This bill will be referred to the joint survey committee on tax exemptions for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to the bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. ^X 77.54 (43) ⁴⁴ of the statutes is created to read:

4 77.54 (43) ⁴⁴ The gross receipts from the sale of goods and services to, and the
5 storage, use or other consumption of goods and services by, a [✓] state veterans
6 organization, as defined in s. 45.353 (1) (b).[✓]

7 SECTION 2. Effective date.

8 (1) This act takes effect on the first day of the [✓] 2nd month beginning after
9 publication.

Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
