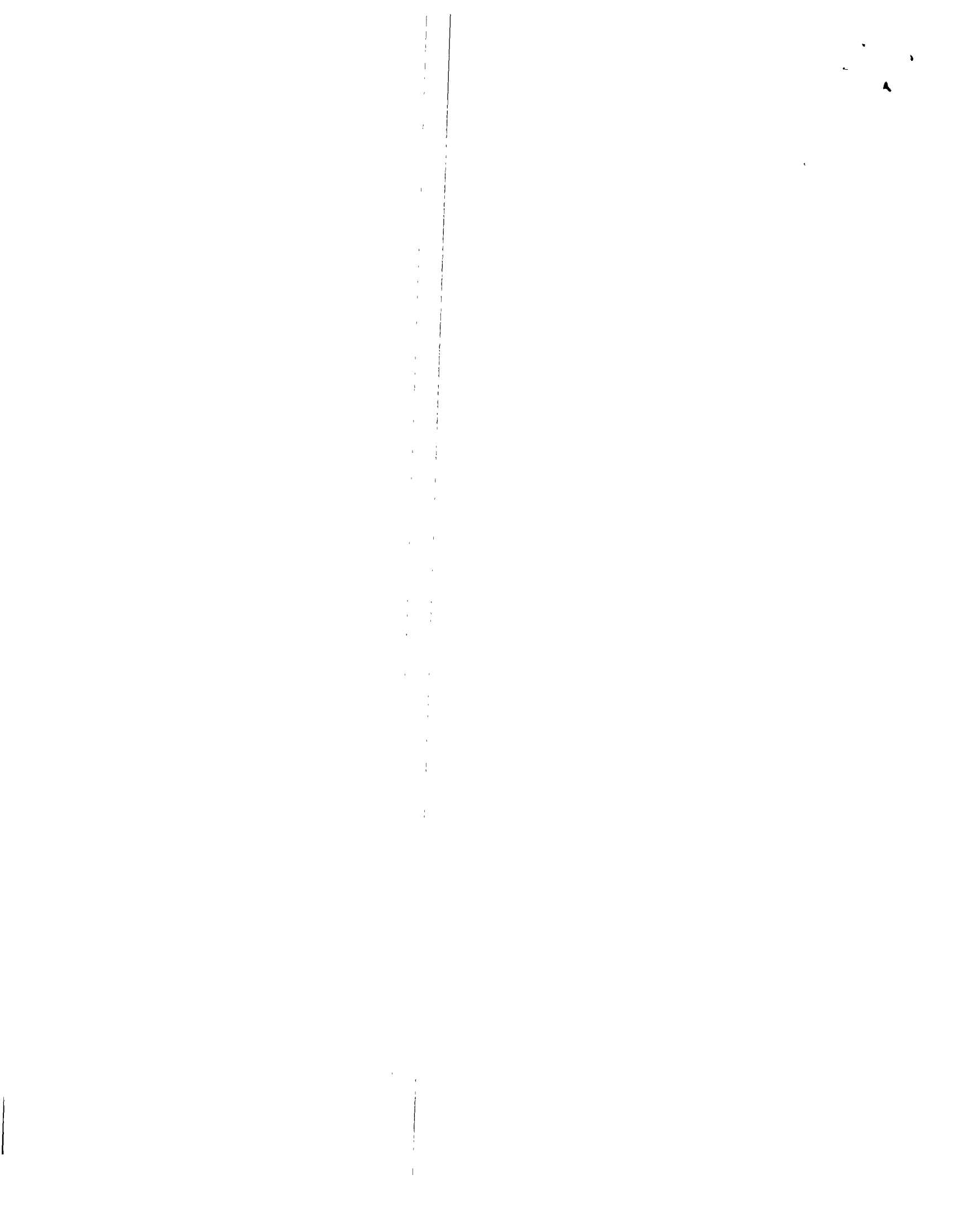

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT ,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 77**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment<sup>✓</sup> as follows:

2 1. Page 2, line 10: after that line insert: *as affected by 1999 Wisconsin Act... (this act),*  
3 "SECTION 2m.<sup>x</sup> 21.11 (1) of the statutes<sup>f</sup> is repealed and recreated to read:

4 ~~21.11 (1) TITLE.~~

5 SECTION. 21.11(1) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 21.11 (1) In case of war, insurrection, rebellion, riot, invasion, resistance to the  
7 execution of the laws of this state, or of the United States, or in the event of public  
8 disaster resulting from flood, conflagration or tornado, or upon application of any  
9 marshal of the United States, the president of any village, the mayor of any city, the  
10 chairperson of any town board, or any sheriff in this state, the governor may order  
11 into active service all or any portion of the national guard. If the governor is absent,  
12 or cannot be immediately communicated with, any such civil officer may, if the officer

1 deems the occasion so urgent, make such application, which shall be in writing, to  
2 the commanding officers of any company, battalion or regiment, who may upon  
3 approval of the adjutant general, if the danger is great and imminent, order out that  
4 officer's command to the aid of such civil officer. Such order shall be delivered to the  
5 commanding officer, who shall immediately communicate the order to each, and  
6 every subordinate officer, and every company commander receiving the same shall  
7 immediately communicate the substance thereof to each member of the company, or  
8 if any such member cannot be found, a notice in writing containing the substance of  
9 such order shall be left at the last and usual place of residence of such member with  
10 some person of suitable age and discretion, to whom its contents shall be explained.

11 **SECTION 3m. Effective date.**

12 (1) The repeal and recreation of section 21.11 (1) of the statutes takes effect on  
13 January 1, 2001."
