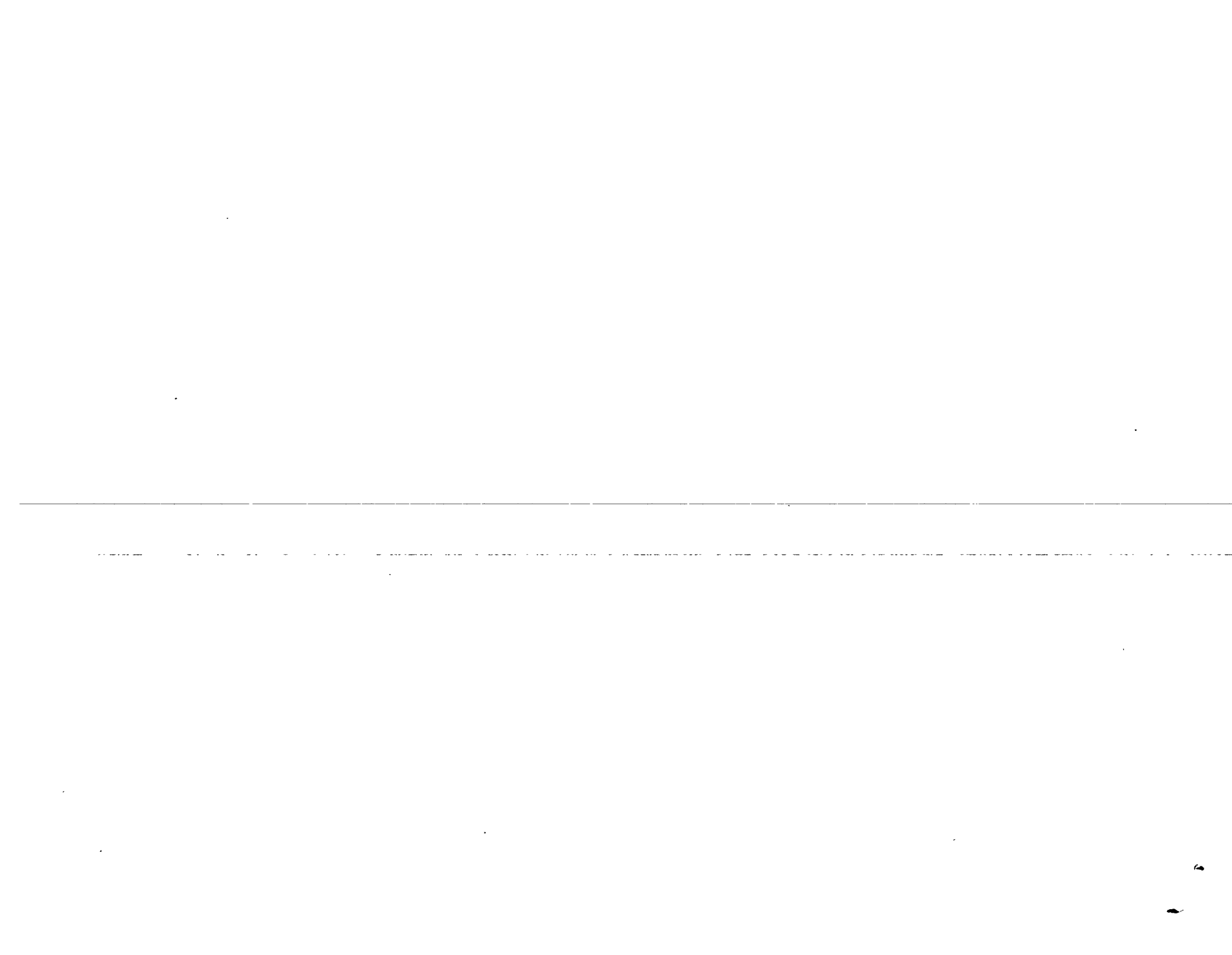

TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 97

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill <sup>✓</sup> as follows:

2 1. Page 3, line 15: after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 8g. <sup>✓</sup> 940.20 (5) (b) (intro.) of the statutes, as affected by 1999  
4 Wisconsin Act <sup>(S)</sup>.... (this act) and ~~1999 Wisconsin Act~~ <sup>✓</sup>.... (Assembly Bill 465), is  
5 repealed and recreated to read:

6 940.20 (5) (b) <sup>(intro.)</sup> Whoever intentionally causes bodily harm to a school officer or  
7 employe under all of the following circumstances is guilty of a Class I felony:

8 SECTION 8r. Nonstatutory provisions.

9 <sup>f</sup> (1~~st~~) RECONCILIATION PROVISION. The repeal and recreation of section 940.20 (5)  
10 (b) (intro.) of the statutes by this act and SECTION ~~8g~~ <sup>c</sup> (1~~st~~) <sup>cc</sup>, (1~~st~~) <sup>cd</sup> and (1~~st~~) of this act  
11 are void unless the treatment of section 940.20 (5) (b) of the statutes by 1999  
12 Assembly Bill 465 is enacted into law before July 1, 2000, in exactly the same form  
13 as it appears in section 308 <sup>✓</sup> of 1999 Assembly Bill 465."

 2           "SECTION 9g. <sup>✓</sup>Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after  
 3 publication, except as follows:

 5 publication of this act and the treatment of section 940.20 (5) (b) <sup>✓</sup> of the statutes by

 7 then the repeal and recreation of section 940.20 (5) (b) (intro.) of the statutes takes  
 8 effect on the day after publication of this act.

 (1~~g~~) If 1999 Assembly Bill 465 has been enacted on or before the day after  
 10 publication of this act and the treatment of section 940.20 (5) (b) of the statutes by  
 11 1999 Assembly Bill 465 takes effect after the day after publication of this act, then  
 12 the repeal and recreation of section 940.20 (5) (b) (intro.) of the statutes by this act  
 13 takes effect on the date that the treatment of section 940.20 (5) (b) of the statutes by  
 14 1999 Assembly Bill 465 takes effect.

 (1~~r~~) If 1999 Assembly Bill 465 is enacted after the day after publication of this  
 16 act but before July 1, 2000, the repeal and recreation of section 940.20 (5) (b) (intro.)

 18 the statutes by 1999 Assembly Bill 465 takes effect."
