ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 103

1	$AN\ ACT$ to amend 118.12 (1); and to create 118.12 (1) (c) of the statutes; relating
2	to: prohibiting school boards from entering into certain contracts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.12 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

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118.12 **(1)** (a) Except as provided under par. pars. (b) and (c), any person may sell or promote the sale of goods or services on school district or cooperative educational service agency property.

(b) A <u>Subject to par. (c)</u>, a school board may adopt written resolutions governing the sale and promotion of goods and services on school district property. The board of control of a cooperative educational service agency may adopt written resolutions governing the sale and promotion of goods and services on agency property. The resolutions may prohibit, restrict or provide guidelines for such sales and promotions.

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1	SECTION 2. 118.12 (1) (c) of the statutes is created to read:
2	118.12 (1) (c) No school board may do any of the following:
3	1. Enter into a contract that prohibits the school board, a school board member
4	a school district employe or a pupil from disparaging the goods or services of the
5	person contracting with the school board.
6	2. Enter into a contract that requires the dissemination of advertising to pupils
7	3. Enter into a contract that grants the right to advertise or sell a particular
8	good or service unless the school board holds a public hearing on the proposed
9	contract.
10	Section 3. Initial applicability.
11	(1) This act first applies to contracts entered into, modified, extended or
12	renewed on the effective date of this subsection.
