**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill provides that a warrant may not be endorsed with an amount and method of posting bail for certain felony crimes against children. The person arrested must be taken before the court prior to release.

No significant impact upon trial court operations is expected as a result of this bill. Presently, it is believed that few felony warrants are endorsed with a bail amount and with crimes such as these courts usually want offenders brought before the court so that specific conditions of release can be set.
