ASSEMBLY SUBSTATUTE AMDI TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 110

(regeneval)

AN ACT to amend 11.33 (1) (b) of the statutes; relating to: use of public funds

by certain state and local officials for production or distribution of certain materials.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, no person who is elected to state or local office and who becomes a candidate for national, state or local office may use public funds for the cost of materials or distribution of 50 or more pieces of substantially identical material after the first day for circulation of nomination papers, or if the person is not nominated by nomination papers, after becoming nominated. The prohibition applies until after the date of the election at which the person's name appears on the ballot unless the person is a candidate for renomination at a primary election and is not nominated, in which case the prohibition applies until after the date of the primary election.

This bill provides that, if a person is elected to succeed himself or herself, this prohibition applies until after the date of the election at which the person is reelected. If a person is not elected to succeed himself or herself, the bill provides that the prohibition applies until the date on which the person ceases to hold office.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

TO 1999-ASSEMBLY BILL (LRB-0835/2)

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, line 4: before that line insert:

SECTION 1. 11.33 (title) and (1) (a) of the statutes are amended to read:

11.33 (title) Use of government materials by candidates public officers.

- (1) (a) No person who is elected to state or local office who becomes a candidate for national, state or local office may use public funds for the cost of materials or distribution for 50 or more pieces of substantially identical material distributed after the earlier of the following dates:
- 1. In the case of a person who becomes a candidate who is nominated for a national, state or local office for which nomination is by nomination papers, the first day authorized by law for circulation of nomination papers as a candidate for that office.

2. In the case of a person who becomes a candidate for a national, state or local office and who is nominated for that office at a primary election by write—in votes, the day the board of canvassers issues its determination that the person is nominated.

- 3. In the case of a person who becomes a candidate for a national, state or local office and who is nominated for that office at a caucus, the date of the caucus.
- 4. In the case of any other a person who becomes a candidate for any national, state or local office and who is nominated for that office solely by filing a declaration of candidacy, the first day of the month preceding the month which includes the last day for filing the declaration.

SECTION 2. 11.33 (1) (a) 5. of the statutes is created to read:

11.33 (1) (a) 5. In the case of a person who is not a candidate for a national, state or local office, the first day of the month preceding the month which includes the last day for filing a declaration of candidacy to succeed that person in office.
