1 AN ACT to amend 118.01 (2) (c) 6. of the statutes; relating to: requiring  
2 instruction in public schools on the history of organized labor in America and  
3 the collective bargaining process.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill requires that every school board's instructional program in state, national and world history include information on the history of organized labor in America and the collective bargaining process.

For further information see the *local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

SECTION 1. 118.01 (2) (c) 6. of the statutes is amended to read:

118.01 (2) (c) 6. Knowledge of state, national and world history, including knowledge of the history of organized labor in America and the collective bargaining process.

If you choose to introduce the proposal without the fiscal estimate, the fiscal estimate will be requested automatically upon introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
