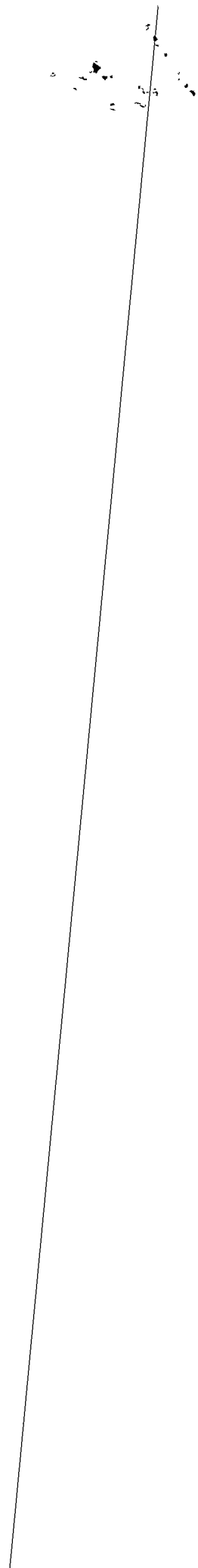

1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 138

February 24, 1997 - Introduced by Representatives FREESE, WALKER, BOCK, LADWIG, HANSON, GOETSCH, R. YOUNG, GREEN, BLACK, HARSDFORF, BAUMGART, DOBYNS, CULLEN, NASS, ZIEGELBAUER, AINSWORTH, ALBERS, BRANDEMUEHL, HAHN, JENSEN, JOHNSRUD, OLSEN, OTTE, OWENS, SERATTI, SYKORA and KAUFERT, cosponsored by Senators CLAUSING, SCHULTZ, COWLES and FARROW. Referred to Committee on Government Operations.

- 1 AN ACT to create 19.45 (8m) of the statutes; relating to: service by a former
2 member of the legislature as a lobbyist.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits any individual who serves as a member of the legislature, for 12 months following the date on which the individual ceases to hold office, from being employed as a lobbyist. A "lobbyist" means an individual who is compensated by a principal and whose duties include attempting to influence state legislative action or state administrative rule-making action on behalf of the principal, except that an individual whose duties on behalf of a principal are not limited exclusively to lobbying is a "lobbyist" only if the individual makes lobbying communications on each of at least 5 days during a 6-month reporting period. Violators are subject to a forfeiture (civil penalty) of not more than \$5,000 for each violation. Intentional violators are guilty of a misdemeanor and are subject to a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$5,000 or imprisonment for not more than one year or both for each violation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- 3 SECTION 1. 19.45 (8m) of the statutes is created to read:



introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to

introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
