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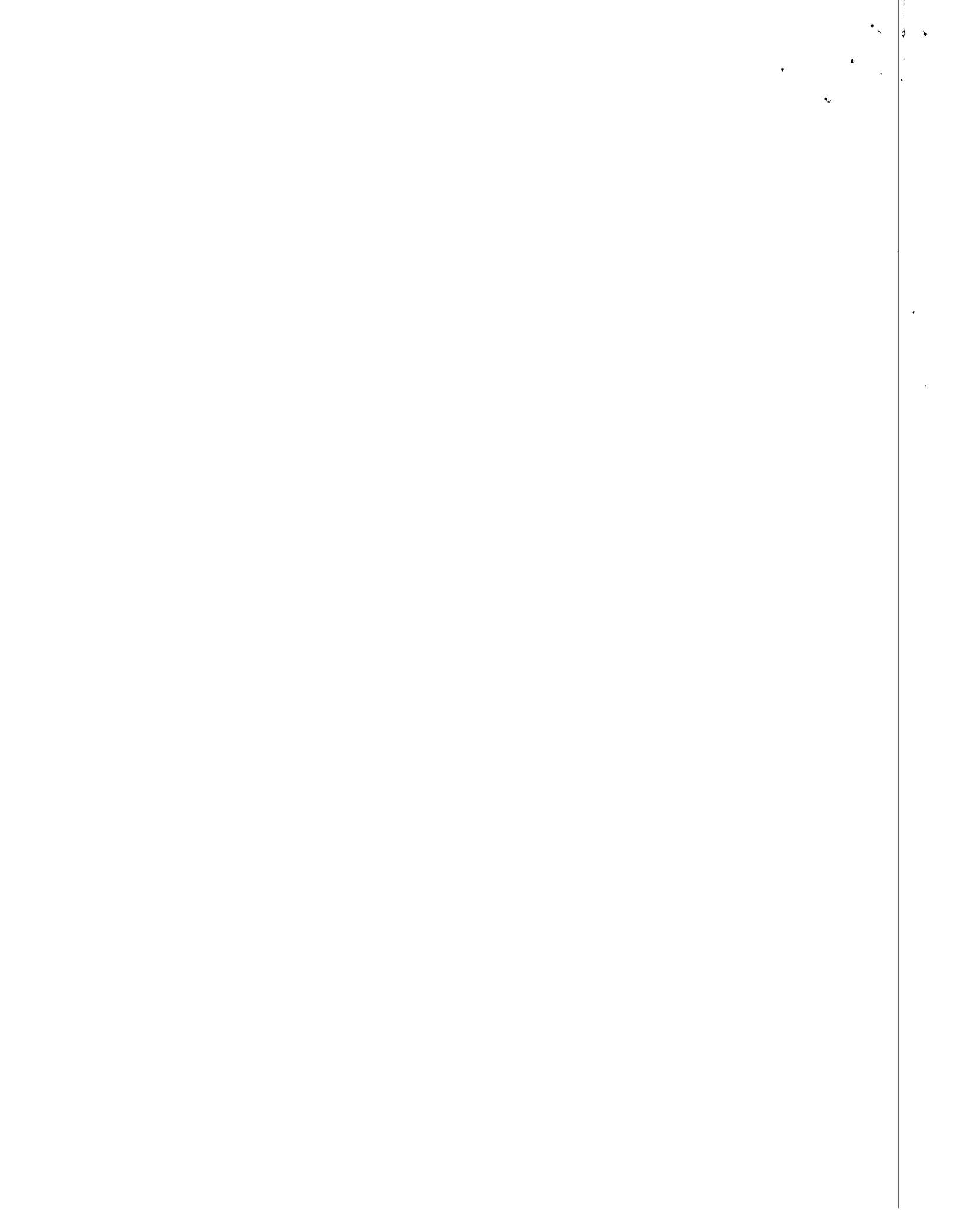

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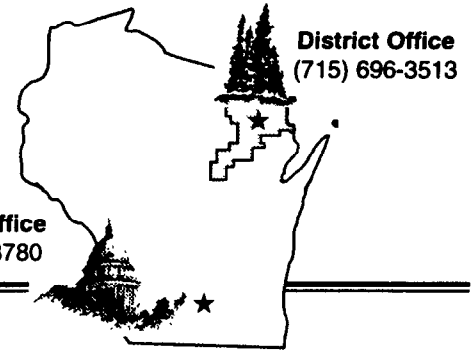

# 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 938

1 AN ACT relating to: directing the legislative fiscal bureau to study the tax on  
2 personal property.

### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill directs the legislative fiscal bureau to study the advantages and disadvantages of discontinuing the tax on personal property.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

### SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) STUDY OF THE TAX ON PERSONAL PROPERTY. The legislative fiscal bureau shall study the economic impact of discontinuing the tax that is imposed on personal property and shall describe the advantages and disadvantages of discontinuing that tax. The legislative fiscal bureau shall report the results of its study to the legislature in the manner <sup>described</sup> under section 13.172 (2) <sup>X</sup> of the statutes <sup>✓</sup> on or before

December 1, 1998

no later

10 than the first day of the 6th month <sup>(END) ✓</sup> <sup>beginning</sup> after the <sup>effective date</sup> of this subsection.



3. Obtain **FISCAL ESTIMATE NOW**, prior to introduction \_\_\_\_\_.

If the analysis indicates that a fiscal estimate is required because the proposal makes an appropriation or increases or decreases existing appropriations or state or general local government fiscal liability or revenues, you have the option to request the fiscal estimate prior to introduction. If you choose to introduce the proposal without the fiscal estimate, the fiscal estimate will be requested automatically upon introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
