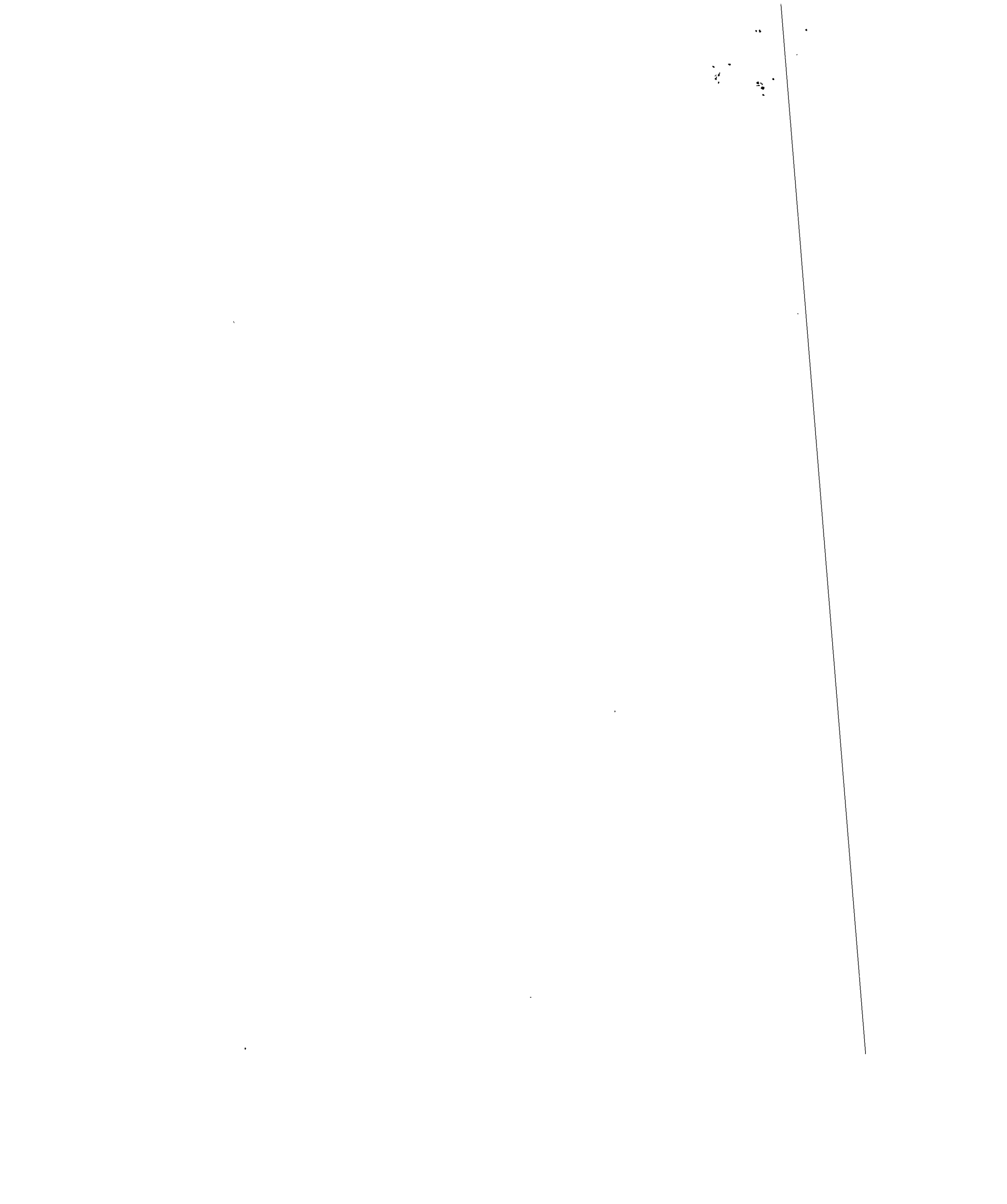

2 and briefs.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill creates a sales and use tax exemption for the sale, lease, rental, storage, use or other consumption of incontinent underpads and briefs.

This bill will be referred to the joint survey committee on tax exemptions for a detailed analysis, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

For further information see the ***state and local*** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 77.54 (40m) of the statutes is created to read:

4 77.54 (40m) The gross receipts from the sale, lease or rental of and the storage,
5 use or other consumption of incontinent underpads and briefs used by a person who
6 has a prescription for incontinent underpads and briefs written by a person
7 authorized to prescribe incontinent underpads and briefs.

8 SECTION 2. Effective date.
