- 1. Note the date for the report under s. 118.035 (5). If this bill does not pass until 2000, you may wish to change the date for the report to July 1, 2003.
- 2. Since 1995 AB–824 was introduced, state law relating to charger schools has changed. Section 118.40 (2r), stats., now authorizes the city of Milwaukee, the University of Wisconsin–Milwaukee and Milwaukee Area Technical College to establish a charter school or contract for the operation of a charter school. Although these charter schools must be located in the Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) school district, they have no connection to MPS. Nevertheless, under this draft, MPS board policy on uniforms would apply to these charter schools. If you wish to modify the draft to eliminate this effect, please let me know.
