3 **SECTION 1^g.** 77.54 (44) of the statutes is created to read:

4 77.54 (44) The gross receipts from the sale, lease or rental of, and the storage,
5 use or other consumption of, school uniforms and related accessories that are
6 required under policies adopted under s. 118.035 (2).[✓]

7 **2.** Page 1, line 2: delete "SECTION 1" and substitute "SECTION 1r". No bold

8 **3.** Page 2, line 24: after that line insert:

9 **SECTION 1^t Effective date.**

10 (1^g) This act takes effect on the first day of the 2nd month beginning after
11 publication."
