

AN ACT ...; relating to: requiring that personal flotation devices be worn by

certain underaged persons in certain boats.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, each boat must have on it a personal flotation device for each person riding in or on the boat. Under this bill, each person 19 years old or younger who is riding in a boat that is less than 26 feet in length must wear a personal flotation device while the boat is being operated.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do $\sqrt{\text{pars. (b)}}$ and (c) enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 30.62 (3) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

30.62 (3) (a) Every boat, except a sailboard and except as provided in par-(b) shall carry at least one personal flotation device prescribed by federal regulations for each person on board or being attended by the boat, so placed as to be readily accessible and available to the persons.

In examining some of the other bills from other states, I find that they exempt from the requirement the following:

Chedren


1) Persons who are below the deck;

2) Persons who are in cabin spaces;

Dent draft

3) Watercraft being operated on private property.

I would like to incorporate these exceptions into this bill. In addition, I question what the definition of the word "operated" is which appears on page 2, line 3. Is there a good definition of the word operated? I note that some of the bills from other states use the term "underway". I wonder if there is a distinction between the terms operated or underway and whether either term is already defined under our statutes. Regardless of which word we choose to use, we should make sure that there is a definition that appears in the statutes so that the term will be clear.
