This bill permits the department to contract with private persons for the transfer and confinement of Wisconsin prisoners within the state. In order to provide a fiscal estimate, the department has reviewed its existing out of state and in-state contracts, some of which are with private entities and some with other governmental entities. Factors that affect the daily rate include provision of health care services, program and treatment services, security, and transportation. The department also employs contract monitors to make frequent inspections of contract facilities, as well as support staff for processing and this cost could increase with added contract facilities.								
Although it is not possible to make an accurate fiscal estimate without knowing the facility involved, the department estimates a range of approximately \$40-\$60 per day per inmate. This is the range currently paid by the state for contract beds in and out of state.
