**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT ,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 190**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 5, line 8: delete lines 8 and 9 and substitute:

3 **"SECTION 2m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) Notwithstanding section 13.40 (6) of the statutes, as created by this act, for
5 the purpose of determining the amount that may be appropriated from general
6 purpose revenue for the 1999-2001 biennium, the legislative fiscal bureau shall
7 make the determinations required under section 13.40 (6) of the statutes, as created
8 by this act, no later than the first day of the 2nd month after the effective date of this
9 subsection.

10 (2) Notwithstanding section 13.40 (8) of the statutes, as created by this act, for
11 the purpose of determining the amount that may be appropriated from general
12 purpose revenue for the 1999-2001 biennium, the legislative fiscal bureau shall

1 submit the report to the cochairpersons of the joint committee on finance that is
2 required under section 13.40 (8) of the statutes, as created by this act, no later than
3 the first day of the 2nd month after the effective date of this subsection. If the
4 cochairpersons of the committee do not notify the secretary of revenue and the
5 director of the legislative fiscal bureau that the committee has scheduled a meeting
6 for the purpose of reviewing the estimates and determinations by the 10th day
7 following their submittal, the estimates and determinations shall be effective. If, by
8 the 10th day following the submittal of the estimates and determinations, the
9 cochairpersons of the committee notify the secretary and director that the committee
10 has scheduled a meeting for the purpose of reviewing the estimates and
11 determinations, the estimates and determinations are not effective unless approved
12 or approved with modifications by the committee.”

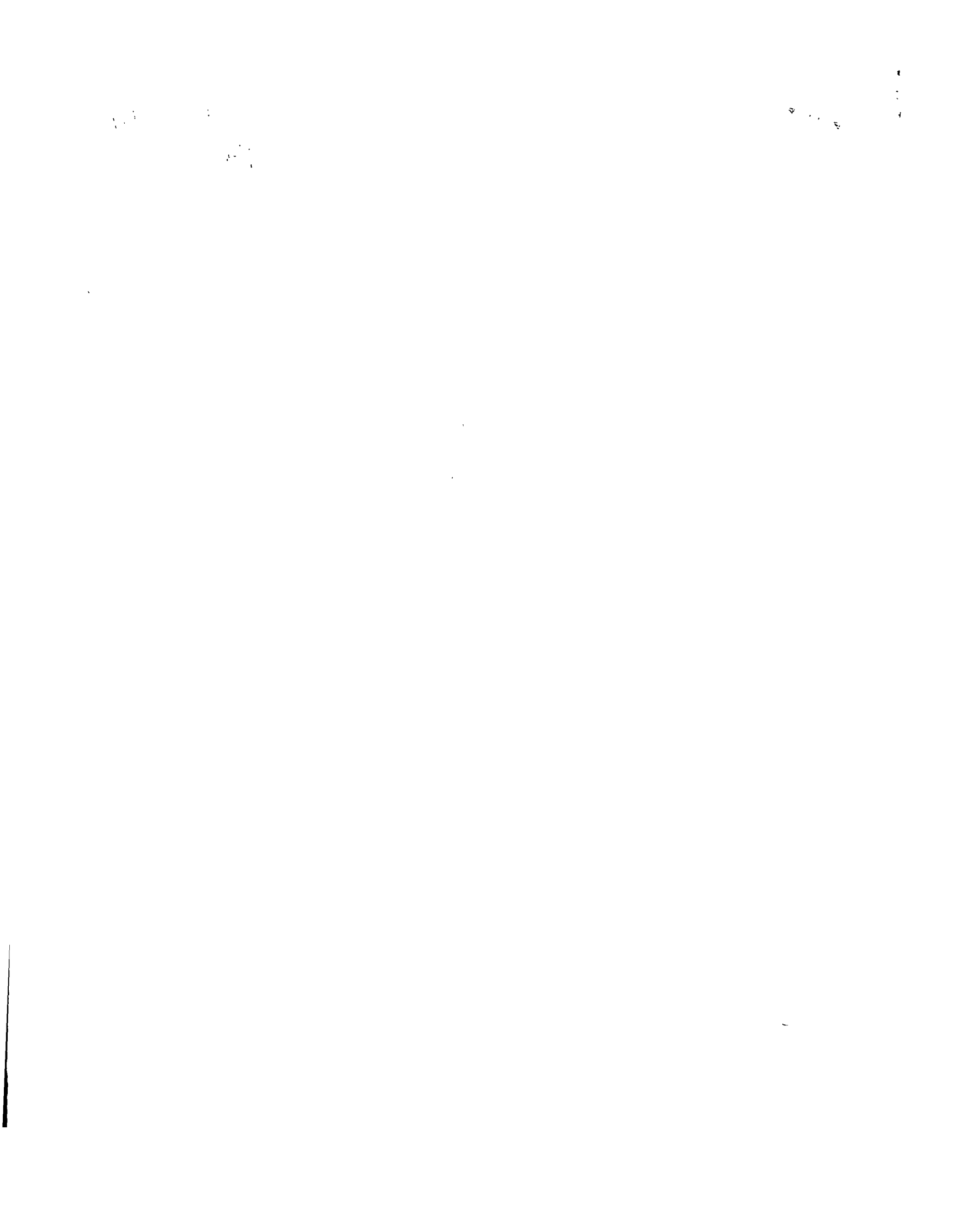
