This bill would prohibit smoking in buildings on post-secondary school campuses.

The technical college system's sixteen districts operate a total of 46 campuses. Each district has a non-smoking policy that applies to all areas of all of the buildings on its campuses. Therefore, the technical colleges would already be in compliance with this legislation if it were enacted, and there would be no fiscal impact.
