The Act also required the committee to make recommendations regarding the reclassification of felonies and certain misdemeanors and to submit a report to the governor and legislature by April 30, 1999. This bill extends the deadline for submission of the report to August 31, 1999, and provides for the continuation of 1.00 FTE project attorney until that date. The bill also provides GPR funding of \$60,000 in FY00 in support for the committee. This bill would extend the Department of Administration appropriation under s. 20.505(3)(c) and would increase GPR costs in FY00 by \$60,000.
