

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 223**

October 26, 1999 – Offered by Representatives URBAN and COLON.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 5: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 1L.** 961.571 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

4 961.571 **(1m)** “Needle exchange program” means a program to which all of the  
5 following apply:

6 (a) The program collects objects specified in sub. (1) (b) 1. that have been used  
7 to inject substances into the human body and properly disposes of the objects or  
8 provides unused objects in exchange for the used objects.

9 (b) The program is operated by a state agency, as defined in s. 20.001 (1), a local  
10 governmental unit, as defined in s. 16.97 (7), a hospital, as defined in s. 50.33 (2), a  
11 treatment facility, as defined in s. 51.01 (19), a health care provider, as defined in s.  
12 48.981 (2m) (b) 1., or a private nonprofit organization.

13 **SECTION 1r.** 961.573 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:
