Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, if an individual who or committee which is required to file a report under the campaign finance law files a false report, the individual or committee is subject to a forfeiture (civil penalty) of not more than \$500.

This bill provides, in lieu of this penalty, that if an individual who or committee which makes disbursements (expenditures) or incurs obligations in support of or in opposition to a candidate independently of any candidate who is supported or whose opponent is opposed files a report which understates or overstates by more than ~~\$1,000~~ ^{\$5,000} the cumulative amount of disbursements ~~made~~ ^{incurred} or obligations incurred by the individual or committee as of any date during the ~~7~~ ^{seven}-day period preceding any primary or other election, the individual or committee must forfeit an amount equal to the amount overstated or understated in excess of ~~\$1,000~~ ^{\$5,000}. ^{-those}
