Currently, if an individual who or committee which is required to file a report under the campaign finance law files a false report, the individual or committee is subject to a forfeiture (civil penalty) of not more than \$500.

This bill provides, in lieu of this penalty, that if an individual who or committee which makes disbursements (expenditures) or incurs obligations in support of or in opposition to a candidate independently of any candidate who is supported or whose opponent is opposed files a report which understates or overstates by more than \$1,000) the cumulative amount of disbursements made or obligations incurred by the individual or committee as of any date during the Jay period preceding any primary or other election, the individual or committee must forfeit an amount equal to the amount overstated or understated in excess of \$1,000.


