

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 252**

September 23, 1999 – Offered by Representatives SERATTI and HUBLER.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2           **1.** Page 2, line 24: after that line insert:

3           “**SECTION 4g.** 23.33 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

4           23.33 (5) (a) *Age restriction.* No person under 12 years of age may operate an  
5 all-terrain vehicle unless he or she is operating the all-terrain vehicle for an  
6 agricultural purpose and he or she is under the supervision of a person over 18 years  
7 of age or unless he or she is operating a small all-terrain vehicle on an all-terrain  
8 vehicle trail designated by the department and he or she is accompanied by his or her  
9 parent. No person who is under 12 years of age may operate an all-terrain vehicle  
10 which is an implement of husbandry on a roadway under any circumstances. No  
11 person who is under 12 years of age may operate an all-terrain vehicle on a roadway  
12 under the authorization provided under sub. (4) (d) 6. under any circumstances. No  
13 person who is under 12 years of age may operate an all-terrain vehicle on a roadway

1 or shoulder of a highway as authorized under sub. (4) (dm) under any circumstances.

2 No person who is under 12 years of age may rent or lease an all-terrain vehicle. For  
3 purposes of this paragraph, supervision does not require that the person under 12  
4 years of age be subject to continuous direction or control by the person over 18 years  
5 of age.

6 **SECTION 4r.** 23.33 (5) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 23.33 (5) (b) *All-terrain vehicle safety certificate.* A person who is at least 12  
8 years of age but under 16 years of age may not operate an all-terrain vehicle unless  
9 he or she holds a valid all-terrain vehicle safety certificate or is accompanied by a  
10 person over 18 years of age. A person who is at least 12 years of age but under 16  
11 years of age may not operate an all-terrain vehicle on a roadway under the  
12 authorization provided under sub. (4) (d) 6. unless he or she holds a valid all-terrain  
13 vehicle safety certificate regardless if he or she is accompanied by a person over 18  
14 years of age. A person who is at least 12 years of age but under 16 years of age may  
15 not operate an all-terrain vehicle which is an implement of husbandry on a roadway  
16 under the authorization provided under sub. (4) (d) 5. unless he or she holds a valid  
17 all-terrain vehicle safety certificate regardless if he or she is accompanied by a  
18 person over 18 years of age. A person who is at least 12 years of age but under 16  
19 years of age may not operate an all-terrain vehicle under the authorization provided  
20 under sub. (4) (dm) unless he or she holds a valid all-terrain vehicle safety certificate  
21 and is accompanied by a person over 18 years of age. A person who is at least 12 years  
22 of age but under 16 years of age may not rent or lease an all-terrain vehicle. A person  
23 who is at least 12 years of age but under 16 years of age who holds an all-terrain  
24 vehicle safety certificate shall carry it while he or she operates an all-terrain vehicle  
25 and shall display it to a law enforcement officer on request. Persons enrolled in a

1 safety certification program approved by the department may operate an all-terrain  
2 vehicle in an area designated by the instructor.”.
