January 21, 1999 Introduced by Representatives DUFF, WARD, ZIEGELBAUER, GOETSCH, LA FAVE, SPILLNER, PLOUPE, HANDRICK, GRONEMUS, M. LEHMAN, STARKUNAS, MUSSER and POWERS, cosponsored by Senators GROBSCHMIDT, DARIANG and RISSER. Referred to Committee on Education.

- regernet AN ACT to repeal 118.15 (3) (c) of the statutes; relating to: excused absences reduces the number of days & to no more than five each from school. Ánalysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law allows a parent or guardian to excuse his or her child from school for up to ten days each school year. This bill eliminates this provision. The bill does not affect a school board's authority to excuse a child from school in accordance with its written attendance policy and with the written approval of the child's parent or guardian.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.15 (3) (e) of the statutes is repealed.

Section 2. Initial applicability.



### TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 61

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 1, line 3: delete that line and substitute:

"SECTION In. 118.15 (3) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

118.15 (3) (c) Any child excused in writing by his or her parent or guardian before the absence. The school board shall require a child excused under this paragraph to complete any course work missed during the absence. A child may not be excused for more than 10 5 days in a school year under this paragraph.
