Representative Kreuser:

Please review this amendment to make sure that it achieves your intent. In particular, please note the following:

1. This amendment eliminates the delayed effective date that is included in the substitute amendment. I assume that the delayed effective date is required under the substitute amendment in order to allow school districts time to comply with the requirement to install software or provide services. As amended, the substitute amendment does not include this requirement. Therefore, the delayed effective date is not necessary.

2. Do you want the amendment to be revised to clarify what spending is eligible for reimbursement? For example, should it be made clear that a school district that spent money on software or services prior to the effective date of the bill may be reimbursed for such spending?
