

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

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means.

AN ACT to create 73.03 (56) of the statutes; relating to: requiring the department of revenue to prepare and maintain a list of delinquent taxpayer accounts and to post on the internet the top 100 names from the list.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the department of revenue (DOR) to prepare and maintain a list of delinquent taxpayer accounts, which are accounts with tax obligations that are unpaid for more than 90 days after all appeal rights have expired. The list shall contain the names, addresses, type of tax due and amount of tax due, including interest and penalties. The bill also requires DOR to create a site on the internet that contains the top 100 names from the list, and to make available for public inspection a hard copy that contains the name of every person on the list. DOR is required to update the internet site and the list on a monthly basis.
