AN ACT to amend 341.14 (6r) (b) 3. and 341.14 (6r) (fm) 7.; and to create 20.370 (5) (at), 23.0965, 25.40 (1) (a) 18., 341.14 (6r) (b) 7., 341.14 (6r) (f) 54. and 341.145 (2m) of the statutes; relating to: special distinguishing registration plates associated with Ducks Unlimited, Inc., and making an appropriation.

### Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, any group or organization may apply to the department of transportation (DOT) for designation as an authorized special group. If the application is approved, members of the authorized special group may obtain special distinguishing registration plates for certain vehicles they register with DOT. Special plates may be obtained for automobiles, station wagons, motor homes and certain dual purpose motor homes, farm trucks and dual purpose farm trucks that are owned or leased by special group members. A fee, in addition to the regular registration fee for the particular kind of vehicle, is assessed for the issuance or reissuance of most special plates.

Before October 2, 1998, authorized special groups whose members may obtain special distinguishing registration plates were specifically enumerated in state law. Current law provides specific enumeration in state law of authorized special groups is limited to those special groups enumerated before October 2, 1998.

Members of authorized special groups related to certain campuses of the University of Wisconsin (UW) System or to the support of endangered or threatened species pay an additional annual fee as a tax deductible contribution to the UW System or to the endangered resources program administered by the department of natural resources.

This bill establishes an authorized special group specifically enumerated in state law for persons interested in obtaining special distinguishing registration plates supporting Ducks Unlimited, Inc., and its conservation efforts in the United States, Canada and Mexico. In addition to the regular vehicle registration fee, special group members are required to pay a \$15 fee for issuance or reissuance of the special plates and an additional \$25 annual fee as a tax deductible contribution that provides funds to Ducks Unlimited, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, for its conservation efforts in the United States, Canada and Mexico. Under the bill, Ducks Unlimited, Inc., is required to annually submit an audited financial statement of its use of the funds received from these tax deductible contributions. Funding to Ducks Unlimited, Inc., is discontinued if the nonprofit organization dissolves or loses its tax—exempt status under federal law.

The bill also provides that, for the first year of plate issuance, up to 350 registration plates with certain registration numbers may not be issued without the prior approval of Ducks Unlimited, Inc., if the special group notifies DOT within 30 days of its designation as an authorized special group of the registration numbers subject to its prior approval.



associated with Ducks Unlimited

The bill allows Ducks Unlimited to give DOT 350 personalized plate messages. While the bill allows these messages despite already existing plate numbers ("Notwithstanding sub (2)(c)...." Page 4, line 23), DOT cannot issue any personalized plate messages that duplicate already issued plate numbers of any plate type. Law enforcement agencies, and individuals who were wrongly cited for traffic violations and other circumstances related to having a plate number duplicate to another number but a different plate type, raised intense objections to the Department and the Legislature. As a result, for the past several years, DOT has not issued *any* duplicate plate number on *any* plate type. This is the reason that S.341.145(2)(c) is specified in statute. The bill author should be aware of the intense objections raised by law enforcement agencies, legislators, and the public about duplicate plate numbers.

Section 8 of LRB 0190/1 (page 4, line 22 – page 5, line 6) is unnecessary, since DOT already has a procedure for individuals to reserve personalized plate messages. Under current procedure, Ducks Unlimited would submit requests for personalized plate messages plus a \$15 fee for each plate number reserved (this fee is then later used as the issuance fee when registration application is made). DOT staff would then check to see whether the plate number is available and if it is not offensive or misleading. If the plate may be issued, DOT staff would reserve the plate number, which remains reserved for 2 years.
