1 AN ACT to create 121.91 (4) (g) of the statutes; relating to: increasing a school  
2 district's revenue limit for expenditures related to participation of pupils in  
3 statewide tournaments and competitions.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau approximately*

Current law limits the increase in the total amount of revenue that a school district may receive from general school aids and property taxes to \$200 per pupil in the 1997-98 school year and, in subsequent school years, to the amount of revenue increase allowed per pupil in the previous school year increased by the percentage change in the consumer price index. Several exceptions exist. For example, if a school district increases the services that it provides by adding responsibility for providing a service transferred to it from another governmental unit, its revenue limit is increased by the cost of that service.

This bill increases a school district's revenue limit in any school year by the amount spent by the school district in the previous school year for participation of pupils in statewide tournaments and competitions.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

SECTION 1. 121.91 (4) (g) of the statutes is created to read:

121.91 (4) (g) The limit otherwise applicable to a school district's revenue under sub. (2m) in any school year is increased by an amount equal to the amount spent by





If you choose to introduce the proposal without the fiscal estimate, the fiscal estimate will be requested automatically upon introduction. It takes about 10 days to obtain a fiscal estimate. Requesting the fiscal estimate prior to introduction retains your flexibility for possible redrafting of the proposal.
