Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate:

1. This bill will require that DOA make an administrative determination, when certifying a joint application from a volunteer health care provider and qualifying nonprofit agency, that to the best of DOA knowledge and based on information in an application, the applicant does not engage in any abortion-related activity as defined under the bill.
2. The bill will also require that DOA ensure that services provided under the program that are not in compliance with the restriction(s) established under this bill will result in no insurance coverage through the State Risk Management program.

The department is unable to accurately estimate the administrative impact of this bill on either the application process (which will require some additional screening statement or the like), or on program administration, and whether the latter would require some added level of nonprofit agency review. At the present time there are approximately 750 health-care providers and 29 non-profit clinics participating in the Volunteer Health Care Provider program.


