Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate <p>This bill makes revisions to the law that requires an unemancipated minor to obtain parental or other consent or a judicial waiver of that consent requirement before she may have an abortion. This includes eliminating the authority of an adult family member to consent to an unemancipated minor's abortion and eliminating the option of permitting a member of the clergy to file a petition and affidavit on behalf of the minor.</p> <p>In 1998, there were an estimated 56 waiver of parental consent petitions filed in the circuit courts. It is impossible to predict the net increase in the number of petitions filed that would occur under this bill. Additional petitions would increase both state and county costs for judge, court reporter, court staff, counsel and guardians ad litem time. These costs are impossible to predict with the data available. It is assumed that any additional workload would be absorbed with existing staff.</p>
