Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill makes various changes to the law that requires an unemancipated minor to obtain parental or other consent or a judicial waiver of the consent requirement before she may have an abortion.

The bill eliminates the authority of an adult family member (grandparent, aunt, uncle, sister or brother who is at least 25 years of age) to consent to an unemancipated minor's abortion. The bill also requires the parent, guardian, legal custodian, foster parent or treatment foster parent who consents to the minor's abortion to sign and acknowledge, that is, declare that he or she has signed the consent document for the purpose stated in the consent document, before a notary public.

In addition, the bill makes other changes to the law regarding exceptions to consent or judicial waiver requirement, civil liability for violation of consent or judicial wavier requirement, and judicial waiver procedures.

It is assumed that this bill will not affect the number of individuals who receive support from Department funded programs such as the Medical Assistance Program or the Healthy Start Program. It is estimated that the bill will have no fiscal effect.
