At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

- 1. Page 4, line 6: delete lines 6 to 25.
- 2. Page 5, line 1: delete lines 1 to 25.
- 3. Page 6, line 1: delete lines 1 to 3 and substitute:

“SECTION 11d. 48.375 (4) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:

48.375 (4) (a) 1. The person or the person’s agent has, either directly or through a referring physician or his or her agent, received and made part of the minor’s medical record, under the requirements of s. 253.10, the voluntary and informed written consent of the minor and the voluntary and informed written consent of one of her the minor’s parents; who has legal custody of the minor or of the minor’s guardian or legal custodian, if one has been appointed; ~~or of an adult family member of the minor; or of one of the minor’s foster parents or treatment foster parents, if the~~

~~minor has been placed in a foster home or treatment foster home and the minor's parent has signed a waiver granting the department, a county department, the foster parent or the treatment foster parent the authority to consent to medical services or treatment on behalf of the minor.~~ ✓
