Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, in any county with a population of less than 500,000 (Milwaukee County is currently the only county with a population greater than 500,000), the county board may require that deputy sheriff positions be filled by appointment by the sheriff from a list of all persons with the highest scores for each position based on a competitive examination. The examination may be given by a county civil service commission or by the division of merit recruitment and selection in the department of employment relations (DER). If the examination is given by DER, the department must certify to the sheriff a list of eligible names of all persons with the highest scores on the examination for each position.

Under this bill, if a competitive examination is given by a county civil service commission or by DER, the list of names from which the sheriff selects shall contain all persons who receive a score of at least 70% for each position to be filled.
